

Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest ... continued

What is the nature of Sunday worship?

In the Sunday assembly the faithful manifest the Church through active participation and a true spirit of community. Through Word and Eucharist they are renewed spiritually under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

The celebration of the Eucharistic sacrifice is carried out by the priest in the person of Christ. This makes the manifestation of the Paschal Mystery complete. When this is not possible, for extraordinary reasons, then Sunday worship would take one of the forms found in the rituals of *Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest*. These forms remain a sign of unity that may include the distribution of Holy Communion. These celebrations should increase the desire of the faithful to be rpesent at and participate in the celebration of the Eucharist.

What are the roles of those who participate in *Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest*? By virtue of their baptism the faithful have various roles as they actively participate in Sunday celebrations in the absence of a priest.

The Assembly—The assembly actively participates through singing, responding, listening, reflecting and praying. The Deacon—A deacon leads the assembly in prayer because by the nature of his office the deacon has been given orders to proclaim and preach the Gospel. If a community does not have the service of a deacon then trained lay leaders may lead the gathered assembly.

Lay Leaders—Lay persons are called forth, appointed, trained and commissioned as leaders of prayer for their community.
