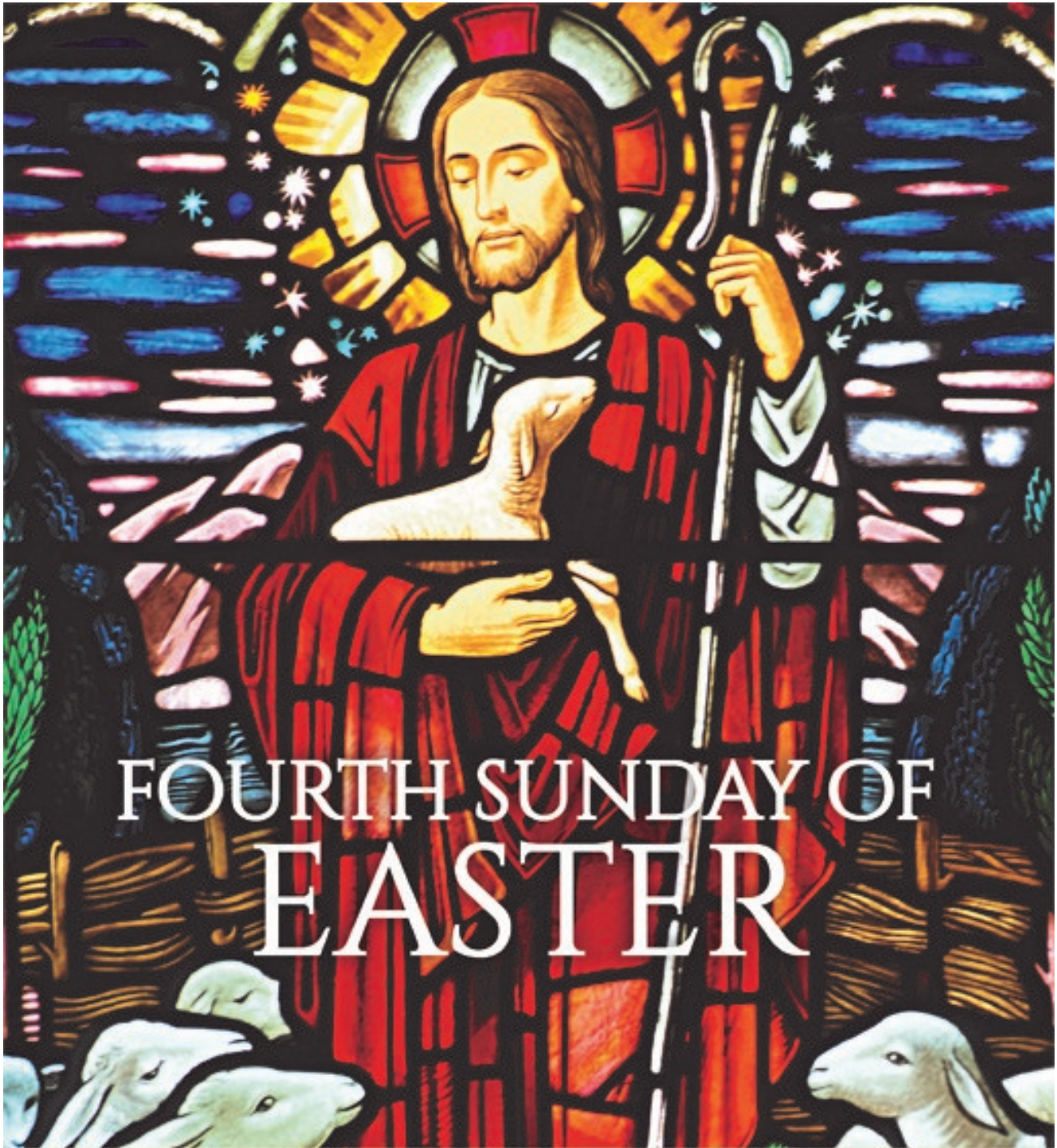

HOLY SPIRIT PARISH



The Pastoral Council (PC) and the Finance Commission (FC) have agreed to a new set of rules governing Fundraising at Holy Spirit Parish. These rules are designed to control the methods used to solicit funds for various parish fundraising activities. These include ticket sales, raffle sales, number and size of signs, personal contacts, costumes, display of novelty items, and number of selling tables. In addition, the new rules control the number of weeks before an event an announcement of the event may be made in the bulletin and the number of weeks fundraising can take place. It also provides for prior approval of all fundraising events by the PC and FC. A copy of these rules will be posted on the bulletin board at each church and a copy may be obtained in the office at each church.

The Pastoral Council (PC) recognizes that fundraising within the church may be necessary to support many of the activities of Holy Spirit Parish. The criteria for fundraising are as follows:

1. All fundraising events must support the ideals and mission of the Church. Proceeds must be targeted for a specific purpose for the benefit of a commission, student group, or an outside beneficiary of a commission or student group, i.e. KOC supporting York County Food Rescue.
2. All fund-raising events must be approved by the PC.
3. Preference is for only one fundraiser at a time with exceptions approved by PC.
4. Sales for an event may be conducted four (4) weeks in advance of the event with advertising via the church bulleting permitted two (2) weeks in advance of start of sales unless otherwise approved by PC.
5. Sales can be conducted before and/or after Mass at the selling table(s) only.
6. Sellers should not approach parishioners before or after Mass, but should respond to questions or provide handouts at the selling table(s).
7. Approved announcements will be permitted after Mass only at the discretion of the Celebrant and preferably by the Celebrant. An announcement made by other than the celebrant must be made from the Cantor station not from the Altar.
8. Advertising signage shall be limited to one per selling table and no larger than 32" by 27".
9. No costumes or lighted displays are permitted.
10. Novelties (e.g. small lobster) that fit on the selling table are permitted.
11. Recommend use of bulletin boards, church bulletins, and/or Parish website to advertise the fundraiser.
12. There shall be no fundraising drives in the church by non-church sponsored groups, unless prior approval is given by the Pastor.
13. A calendar will be maintained by the PC listing all approved fundraisers for the year.

To coordinate the various fundraising efforts, the PC will meet annually in January to discuss and schedule requested events for each church site for the upcoming year. Organizations should submit their ideas for fundraising by December 31, each year, for inclusion in the calendar for the following year. Proposals that are generated during the year will be considered for addition to the calendar by the PC on a case-by-case basis. Sponsoring organizations are requested to submit their ideas for fundraising by filling out the **Request for Fundraising Form—available in the offices.**

Centering Prayer is a method of silent prayer that can serve to prepare us to receive the gift of God's presence. The goal of the workshop is to provide participants with the tools for Centering Prayer and to encourage a daily practice. The workshop will be presented by Fr. D. Joseph Manship, a member of Contemplative Outreach Inc., the organization founded by Fr. Thomas Keating, O.C.S.O., for the purpose of promoting Centering Prayer throughout the world. Centering Prayer is for all who are seeking a deeper relationship with God. Participants are encouraged to attend six weekly sessions following this workshop. The follow up sessions provide support and encourage to those who wish to establish a daily prayer practice.
