Your parishioners have been so generous in all these years to help our parenting mothers when St. Andre had residential group homes for 20 parenting mothers. Many programs have changed in the last year. The Agency now only have two Residential Programs, one for five pregnant young women and the Hope Rising with five beds for Trafficking Services. The other programs are Outreach for Play Therapy and counseling at the Parenting Center on Adams Street in Biddeford. The Adoption Program continues to be active helping Maine Families adopt Interstate or Internationally. This gives you an idea of the changes required to keep the Agency alive helping women and children in need.

Your Mother's Day donations were awesome as usual and we thank you for your generosity.

This will be my last thank you — I am retiring to our convent on 409 Pool Road in Biddeford.

SPIRITUAL EXERCISES OF ST. IGNATIUS: 19TH ANNOTATION RETREAT

Has Pope Francis' prayerfulness and ministry of healing and wholeness caught your attention? Would you like to know what it is that underpins Pope Francis' spirituality? Do you sense Jesus inviting you to "come away" with him for a while? Do you desire to learn how to pray more deeply? Do you wonder how that can happen in the busyness of your daily life? Are you in need of making a major decision?

If you answered yes to any of these questions The 19th Annotation of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius might be just what you are looking for.
