Dear Brother Priests,

With deep gratitude, I write to thank you for your efforts during the start of the 2015 Catholic Appeal. How wonderful it is to see many of our parishes already closing in on their annual goal!

I also write to remind you that we announced an “Appeal end date” of August 31, which is two months away. The purpose of this end date was to create a sense of urgency that would increase early participation by parishioners and encourage parishes to achieve their goals as soon as possible. The anticipated benefits include a reduction in the number of times we reach out to potential donors, thus avoiding donor fatigue and saving on administrative costs.
