New Music Coordinator and New Organ Accompanist

Welcome to Mark Reeth who will join the staff as a part time Music Coordinator. Mark has spent years in the ministry and was so helpful and successful during the interim period that I am proud to make his position more permanent. Since November, Mark has gained the admiration of the Ministry by his excellent skills in management, warm welcoming style and faith-filled dedication to the Church.

Mark is a New Jersey native who moved to Maine five years ago, after having vacationed here for years. A graduate of Villanova University in PA with a bachelor's degree in psychology, and then of Towson University in MD with a master's degree in clinical psychology, Mark worked over 23 years for St. Clare's Hospital in NJ. He was a mental-health clinician and team leader for various programs.

Mark's musical background began during elementary school when he joined the church choir and, subsequently, began taking guitar lessons. His passion for singing has continued to present day. In college, he sang for Campus Ministry, and with the Villanova Singers who presented concerts along the eastern seaboard and in several European countries. During his post-academic years, he sang with the Pocono Choral Society out of Stroudsburg, PA, singing in the northeast U.S. and Nova Scotia. In NJ, Mark was a cantor and guitarist at his home parish for 12 years, a cantor for ordinations to the priesthood and diaconate, and an employee of St. Pius X Church for 12 years, directing a contemporary ensemble of children and adults, as well as having been one of two cantors who covered all Masses. After moving to Maine, he church-shopped" for six months. In December 2010, he was especially moved by a Mass he attended at St. Mary's Church, and felt called to become a part of Holy Spirit Parish.

David Goulet is no stranger to this area. He is professor of Music at Southern Maine University, well-known musician, cantor vocalist at Catholic Church for many years. He was the voice instructor and mentor of our own locally famous young Tim Cilley and currently works with our own Rosie Crimp (the voice of an angel).
