

## THE SISTERS OF ST. FRANCIS

The Sisters of St. Francis' missioners will be speaking at Sunday Masses the last weekend in August (August 29/30) at St. Martha's in Kennebunk and at All Saints' in Ogunquit.

The Sisters serve those who are poor, with foreign missions in Mexico and home missions in Appalachia. In remote areas of Mexico they work to build faith communities where there are no priests for regular Sunday Masses. Sisters also give children living in extreme poverty the opportunity to obtain an education plus emergency needs of food and medicine. Appalachian ministries include faith development and pastoral care, adult literacy, and emergency outreach of food, clothing and shelter for the poor.

Sister Sara Aldridge will be the mission speaker at All Saints, in Ogunquit. She has served in our Appalachian missions.

Sister Jacquelyn Doepker will be the mission speaker at St. Martha's in Kennebunk. She has served in our Appalachian missions.
