(Exodus 12:14) As we approach the Triduum, (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday—Easter Vigil), we can align ourselves more closely with Jesus's human experience, in the celebration of the Passover meal, the Seder. Jesus himself shared such a meal, his last on earth, with his disciples.
