Holy Spirit Parish Outreach Committee

As you undoubtedly know, our Parish is filled with people of many talents who give generously of their time in fulfilling our Christian walk. Certainly an example of this is the Outreach Committee currently chaired by Leo Ouellette. Leo was the Town Treasure for Wells for six years before he retired in 2012. There are ten members of the Parish Outreach Committee. Seven are from St. Mary's, Lillian Fox, Don Kammann, Larry Pare, Bill Sawyer, Linda Wagner, Brian Toomey and Leo. Three are from St. Martha's, Karen Carragher, Mary Lou Kiley and Dan Mahoney.

The Outreach Committee was called "The Tithing Committee" until 2014. At that time the name was changed to reflect the intent of service, and a mission statement was created as follows: "Holy Spirit Parish is a community of Roman Catholic determined to imitate the life of Jesus Christ. The community exists to honor and glorify God. Accordingly, the Community dedicates a tithe of its income in its enduring endeavor to eliminate the injustices and inequities of the less fortunate and needy among us." In addition the committee has in mind serving the "Year of Mercy" as decreed by Pope Francis.

The portion that our Parish community dedicates each month is 7% of the monthly offerings. The Committee guidelines allocate the funds to three main accounts including outreach, heating fuel and scholarships. Outreach includes money for rent, vehicle repairs, electricity, Jamaica mission, water, medical, local disaster (fire, flood, etc.) and help to other Maine parishes as requested by the Diocese. The heating fuel account includes oil and propane. Scholarships are made available to students attending regional Catholic high schools and any college.

The Diocese is responsible to make requests for Catholic organizations coming under their oversight. For individuals and other organizations, all requests must be made in writing on standard forms. The Committee as a whole then reviews the requests, and if approved, submits them to Father Tom for final approval and processing.

Last fiscal year (July through June) almost \$68,000.00 was given which helped a number of Catholic organizations as well as assistance to 69 individuals and five high school/college scholarships. As the need is great, we can know that our Parish is generous. God blesses us so that we may be a blessing to others.
