Holy Spirit Parish Scholarships (applicants family must use Holy Spirit Parish Budget Envelopes AND the St. Martha's K of C Council Scholarships, (which are based on need), are given to graduating students who are members of Holy Spirit Parish and who attend and support the church. Applicants must be entering their freshman year at an institution of higher learning at either a technical college, junior college or a college offering a baccalaureate degree program in the fall of 2016. Scholarships will be paid after successful completion of a first semester/trimester, with a commitment to continue enrollment and upon receipt of a college transcript of the student's 1<sup>st</sup> semester grades.
