

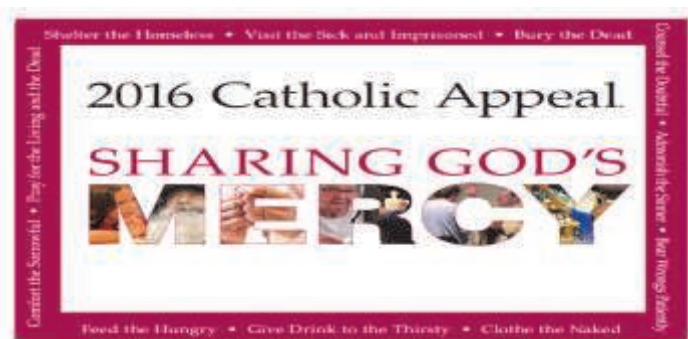

## SPIRITUAL EXERCISES OF ST. IGNATIUS: 19<sup>TH</sup> ANNOTATION RETREAT

Are you: Looking to deepen your relationship with God? Wanting to rekindle your prayer life? Yearning for a greater connectedness with all of creation? Facing a major decision? Wondering about Pope Francis’ beautiful spirituality?
