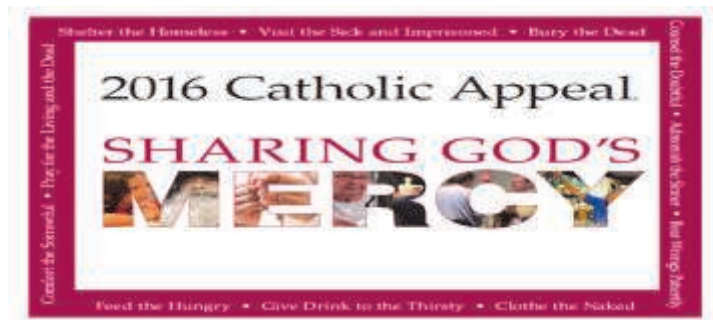

### **A Note from our Diocese about Weddings...**

Parishioners (i.e. couples intending to marry) are reminded that they must contact the pastor/priest of the parish at least six months prior to making any plans for a church wedding. This time is needed to ensure that the freedom of both parties to enter a marriage is established, that the required documents are gathered and proper forms completed, and that adequate catechesis and marriage preparation take place. Both priests and couples are reminded that only a priest or deacon currently assigned to a parish can validly witness or delegate another minister (i.e., that is, only they can delegate either a visiting or retired priest or deacon) to perform a wedding ceremony within their parish.

## SPIRITUAL EXERCISES OF ST. IGNATIUS: 19<sup>TH</sup> ANNOTATION RETREAT

Are you: Looking to deepen your relationship with God? Wanting to rekindle your prayer life? Wondering about Pope Francis' beautiful spirituality? Consider making the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius, 19<sup>th</sup> Annotation Retreat. This 30-week retreat begins in September and ends in May. It is commonly called, "The Retreat of Daily Life". It is held at St. Martha Church, in Kennebunk, on Wednesdays. You would have the choice of EITHER Wednesday morning OR Wednesday evening. Each session consists of meeting one on one with a prayer guide (spiritual director), and listening to a reflection done by one of the guides.
