### BRIEF MEETINGS AND HAND OUTS FOR EM'S AND LECTORS

Fr. Fred will hold brief instructional meetings for current EM's and Lectors with hand-outs around regularly scheduled weekend Masses at our churches concerning some updated mandated adjustments to the Ministry. There will be an easy one sheet reference guide to the adjustments and a longer explanation document for each minister. *These adjustments have already been made at Daily Masses for both churches. You may want to attend a daily Mass (8 AM, St. Mary & 9 AM, St. Martha) to observe some of the adjustments.*

The schedule is as follows: 10/22 after 4 PM Mass at St. Mary; 10/23 after the 8 and before the 11 AM (about 10 AM) at St. Martha; 10/29 after 4 PM Mass, St. Martha; 10/30 after the 9 and before the 11 AM (about 10:15) at St. Mary.

If you only have a storage space, but not a working space, please contact us also. We are often offered furniture or appliances that we cannot accept due to space constraints. **RESULTS OF MASS TIME CHANGE AT ST. MARTHA**

The survey results for the 11 AM Mass returning to 10 AM on Sundays at St. Martha is as follows: In favor of the change to 10 AM: 443; In favor of leaving it at 11 AM: 69, Total votes cast: 512. Almost six and half times more people want it to change then did not. Please know that even before the survey, those staff and organizations within the Parish at St. Martha all agreed with the change to the earlier time.
