

PALM SUNDAY

Holy Week begins with Passion Sunday, or Palm Sunday, and the Gospel story of the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem is read as part of the entrance rite. The Gospel tells us that the people cut branches from the trees and laid them in the road in front of Jesus as part of the procession. Palm is used to celebrate this festive entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. Palms are from a common tree whose branches are readily available. The palm is blessed and people are given a branch to take home. A year later the palm will be burned to form the ash for Ash Wednesday. In other places, churches use olive branches or pussy willows. The blessing in the Sacramentary uses the generic term "branches."

St. Martha Church Haiti basket benefits Mother Teresa's Missionaries of Charity.

There has been a Haiti donation basket available each weekend in the Narthex of St. Martha Church since 1999. Application Deadline: May 14, 2017

The Holy Spirit K of C Council Scholarships, which are based on need, academics, and service are given to graduating students who are members of Holy Spirit Parish and who attend and support the Church. Recipients must be entering their freshman year at an institution of higher learning at either a technical college, junior college or a college offering a baccalaureate degree program. Scholarships will be paid after successful completion of a first semester/trimester, with a commitment to continue enrollment and upon receipt of a college transcript of the student's 1st semester grades. Applications can be picked up in the church offices in Kennebunk or Wells.

Scholarship applications are now available in the offices in Wells and Kennebunk. All high school seniors of the parish entering college, a technical trade, beautician, culinary, and/or secretarial school, may pick one up. All applications must be returned by May 21, 2017.
