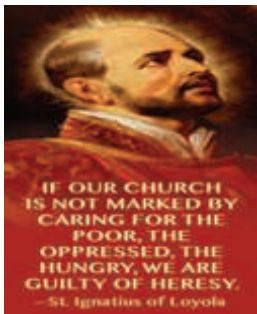
Holy Spirit K of C SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION St. Martha Council 12033 & St. Mary Council 9782

The Holy Spirit K of C Council Scholarships, which are based on need, academics, and service are given to graduating students who are members of Holy Spirit Parish and who attend and support the Church. Recipients must be entering their freshman year at an institution of higher learning at either a technical college, junior college or a college offering a baccalaureate degree program. Scholarships will be paid after successful completion of a first semester/trimester, with a commitment to continue enrollment and upon receipt of a college transcript of the student’s 1st semester grades.
