CAMPUS MINISTRY

“They were the first table I went to on Accepted Student Day and when I was here visiting during orientation,” he says. “I immediately knew, regardless of how many other social activities I have, I could always have this place to come to and to have as a regular touchstone for my week.” Ben was active in youth ministry at All Saints Parish in Brunswick and didn’t want to lose the connection to his faith. “This is picking up where that left off, but here, in a completely new environment, it’s something that I’m leaning on a lot more because there can be a lot of stresses and anxiety,” he says.
