**Three Beliefs:** Suzanne Lafreniere, the Director of the Office of Public Policy for the Diocese of Portland will be speaking on Wednesday, July 19 at 3:00 p.m. at St. Mary's Church in Wells, and 6:00 p.m. at St. Martha's Church in Kennebunk. She will discuss Bishop Deeley's recent promulgated document, Three Beliefs. It is a guide for Maine Catholics that offers valuable assistance and information regarding end-of-life issues. The 20 page document includes an explanation of Catholic teaching on life-sustaining treatment and care and the Maine Advance Directive form modified to ensure consistency with both Catholic teaching and Maine law. Parishioners of all ages are invited to learn more about how to make the difficult choices surrounding end-of-life medical care and how to share them with family and friends now to ensure that your beliefs about the sanctity of human life, the appropriateness of medical care, and the dignity of the dying process are known in advance so they can be met in the future.

**Teams from every U.S. diocese will be accompanying their Bishops to a "Convocation of Catholic Leaders: The Joy of the Gospel in America" July 1st through 4th.** Pope Francis's Apostolic Exhortation *The Joy of the Gospel* will serve as the unifying text for the plenary and small group sessions. The convocation will consider four questions:

(1) What is the nature of his current historical moment in the Church and in our nation?, (2) How do we respond to this moment as missionary disciples?, (3) Where are we called to go? To whom are we being sent on this mission?, and (4) What will we do when we get there? How will we engage the mission? Of course our Bishop Deeley will be attending with various people from the Diocese, including our own Chairperson for Holy Spirit Pastoral Council, Mary Colombo. Please pray that the outcome of this convocation will be a prayerful and committed response to missionary discipleship in our diocese and throughout the country. If you are interested in viewing the plenary sessions, they will be broadcast on EWTN.
