GOSPEL MEDITATION

Happy Trinity Sunday! In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus declare together all three Persons of the Trinity. "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

When we speak of the Trinity, two different theological words are sometimes used: immanent and economic. The immanent Trinity is the life of the three Persons within themselves, the inner harmonious relationship between Father, Son, and Spirit. We see this in the Gospels when Jesus speaks of his Father and promises to send the Holy Spirit. The term "economic" has its roots in the Greek word *oikonomia*, roughly meaning "household management." The economic Trinity is our three-personed relationship with creation; it is creation and redemption and ongoing relationship with us. Made in the image and likeness of God, we are called to imitate God's immanence by giving and receiving love with one another in community. However, this is not limited only to those close to us, though that's where love often starts. We also imitate the economy of God when we go out, when we extend our love and care in a life-giving way. "Go therefore ?"

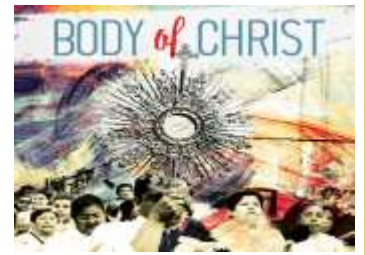

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

Come and celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi on **Sunday, June 3**, at Most Holy Trinity in Saco. Eucharistic Adoration will take place 11:30 AM to 6 PM. The 6 PM Holy Hour will be followed by a procession to the Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel. The Chapel is located on Thornton Avenue in Saco, in the convent adjacent to the former Notre Dame de Lourdes Church.



Also, consider spending one hour per week at the Adoration Chapel. Christ said He would be with us always, until the end of time. In the Holy Eucharist, He is. The Eucharist truly is Jesus Christ under the appearance of bread. By spending time in adoration, we allow ourselves to be transformed by that encounter. During the summer months, it is a tradition at St. Mary Church in Wells to increase the number of Extraordinary Ministers for Communion for the distribution of the Consecrated Hosts, and to eliminate the cups with the Precious Blood. This is due to the sizes of the congregations and the increase in Masses in Wells, as well as to the addition of the Ogunquit Summer Mission. We will, however, have one cup with the Precious Blood at the back of the middle aisle for those who have a wheat allergy. In Ogunquit, we will continue to have Hosts only. Remember that this only pertains to the Wells and Ogunquit churches. Kennebunk will remain as it is with Hosts and Precious Blood at all Masses.
